

The team were covering a few areas today that just needed a quick tidy up. First, we cleared away the overgrowing bramble from the corner of Bridge Street and High Street. We do this area a few times during the year to keep it down as much as possible as it's such a well-used path. Just one brown bin used there today.



The team split up then with Karen and Julie tidying away the weeds from the pavement over Barrow Bridge.

They also did a great job of removing lots of ivy growing around the gate at the entrance to the slabs and gave the whole area a good cutting back in general. Another brown bin filled.

Thanks to Charnwood Borough Council and Serco for the brown bins.

The rest of the team headed along the towpath from Deep Lock towards the Navigation to give the hedges a light summer cutback to remove nettles and bramble that were beginning to make the towpath very narrow in places.

We also cut back some of the heavy and very low hanging branches from trees to allow a bit more sun light in and hopefully prevent cyclists, runners or anyone walking along from knocking their heads as they used the towpath.



We also had some time to say hello to some of the locals – they are a friendly lot.
