

The team started at the top of the railway bridge:



We then moved across the bridge - this part of the jitty can feel unsafe underfoot due to the path being so steep so we cut back any overgrowth and sweep away any build-up of leaf debris a couple of times each year to keep on top of it.

We'll need another visit towards the end of the year once all the leaves have fallen.

We also tidied up the green area at the bottom, reclaiming some of the path back from where the soil has been slipping over.
