


Location: Strancliffe Lane jitties

Our final task of the year was the footpath running between Humphrey Perkins School and Strancliffe Hall. We've cleared this footpath a number of times already, sometimes the overgrowth and other times to clear the rubbish. This time we were able to do both. Lots of rubbish collected again that has blown around from the school playing fields, but we also cut back lots of ivy from the railings to make the path a little wider.



We cut back lots of bramble from the scrubs at the top end of the footpath closer to Buttermere Way, again making the path a little wider. The bramble will inevitably grow back in the spring, but it should be a little easier to manage each time will give it a cut back to ground level.
